


Born into significance




Luke 1:15 for he will be great in the sight of the Lord... 16 Many of the people of Israel will he bring back to the Lord their God.

came only as a witness to the light.





13 "Don't collect any more than you are required to," he told them.


14 Then some soldiers asked him, "And what should we do?" He replied,

17 His winnowing fork is in his hand to clear his threshing-floor and to gather the wheat into his barn, but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire."






Mark 1:5 The whole Judean countryside and all the people of Jerusalem went out to him. Confessing their sins, they were baptised by him in the Jordan River.









