## Hebrews 9:23-24 NIV







It was necessary, then, for the copies of the heavenly things to be purified with these sacrifices, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these. For Christ did not enter a man-made sanctuary that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence.

## Hebrews 10:1-2 NIV



The law is only a shadow of the good things that are coming— not the realities themselves. For this reason it can never, by the same sacrifices repeated endlessly year after year, make perfect those who draw near to worship. If it could, would they not have stopped being offered? For the worshippers would have been cleansed once for all, and would no longer have felt guilty for their sins.

#### Hebrews 8:5 NIV







They serve at a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven. This is why Moses was warned when he was about to build the tabernacle: "See to it that you make everything according to the pattern shown you on the mountain."

#### Exodus 24:1-2 NIV







Then he said to Moses, "Come up to the LORD, you and Aaron, Nadab and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel. You are to worship at a distance, but Moses alone is to approach the LORD; the others must not come near. And the people may not come up with him."

#### Exodus 24:18 NIV







Then Moses entered the cloud as he went on up the mountain. And he stayed on the mountain forty days and forty nights.

#### Exodus 25:8 NIV







Then have them make a sanctuary for me, and I will dwell among them. Make this tabernacle and all its furnishings exactly like the pattern I will show you.

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#### Acts 7:38-39 NIV







He (Moses) was in the assembly in the desert, with the angel who spoke to him on Mount Sinai, and with our fathers; and he received living words to pass on to us. "But our fathers refused to obey him."

#### Acts 7:44 NIV







Our forefathers had the tabernacle of the Testimony with them in the desert. It had been made as God directed Moses, according to the pattern he had seen.

#### Acts 7:48-49 NIV







However, the Most High does not live in houses made by men. As the prophet says: "Heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool. What kind of house will you build for me? says the Lord. Or where will my resting place be?"

#### Acts 7:52-54 NIV







"Was there ever a prophet your fathers did not persecute? They even killed those who predicted the coming of the Righteous One. And now you have betrayed and murdered him you who have received the law that was put into effect through angels but have not obeyed it." When they heard this, they were furious and gnashed their teeth at him.

The point of what we are saying is this: We do have such a high priest, who sat down at the right hand of the throne of the Majesty in heaven, and who serves in the sanctuary, the true tabernacle set up by the Lord, not by man.

But those sacrifices are an annual reminder of sins, because it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. Therefore, when Christ came into the world, he said: "Sacrifice and offering you did not desire, but a body you prepared for me; with burnt offerings and sin offerings you were not pleased.

#### 1 Samuel 15:22-23 NIV



But Samuel replied: "Does the LORD delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as much as in obeying the voice of the LORD? To obey is better than sacrifice, and to heed is better than the fat of rams. For rebellion is like the sin of divination, and arrogance like the evil of idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, he has rejected you as king."

## Hebrews 10:7 NIV







Then I said, 'Here I am—it is written about me in the scroll—I have come to do your will, O God.'

## Jesus' sacrifice was:

- Written in the scroll

#### Deuteronomy 17:18-19 NIV



When he takes the throne of his kingdom, he is to write for himself on a scroll a copy of this law, taken from that of the priests, who are Levites. It is to be with him, and he is to read it all the days of his life so that he may learn to revere the LORD his God and follow carefully all the words of this law and these decrees

## Jesus' sacrifice was:







- (v7)
- Written in the scroll

## Hebrews 10:8-9 NIV



First he said, "Sacrifices and offerings, burnt offerings and sin offerings you did not desire, nor were you pleased with them" (although the law required them to be made). Then he said, "Here I am, I have come to do your will." He sets aside the first to establish the second.

- ...God's will

#### Genesis 3:15 NIV







And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel.

## Hebrews 10:10 NIV







And by that will, we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

## Jesus' sacrifice was:







- (v10)
- ...thoroughly cleansed

#### Hebrews 10:11-12 NIV



Day after day every priest stands and performs his religious duties; again and again he offers the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But when this priest had offered for all time one sacrifice for sins, he sat down at the right hand of God.

#### Jesus' sacrifice was:







- (v10)
- ...thoroughly cleansed
- (v11,12)
- ...was completed by this priest who is now in Heaven

#### Hebrews 10:13-14 NIV







Since that time he waits for his enemies to be made his footstool, because by one sacrifice he has made perfect for ever those who are being made holy.

### Jesus' sacrifice was:



#### • (v10)

- ...thoroughly cleansed
- (v11,12)
- ...completed by this priest in Heaven
- (v13,14)
- ...is the means of our holiness, even in the middle of threats by God's enemies
