Jerusalem in the Time of Jesus

The exact appearance of Jerusalem 2,000 years ago will never be known, but ongoing archaeological research has given scholars enough data to develop highly plausible reconstructions. This view of the city, looking east toward the Temple, is based on a model built from research done by Prof. Michael Avi-Yonah of Hebrew University in Jerusalem. The numbered sites are identified in the listing below.
