## 4. Fulfillment of Prophecy- Ps. 78:2-Matt. 13:34,35

34 All these things Jesus spoke to the multitude in parables; and without a parable He did not speak to them, 35 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: " I will open My mouth in parables; I will utter things kept secret from the foundation of the world." (Ps. 78:2)


1. Literal- asserts that a biblical text is to be interpreted according to the plain meaning conveyed by its grammatical construction and historical context. ”






# The Kabbalah system? (Jewish gnosticism)

In the Zohar (155 B), the Hebrew Book of Splendour, it is said that God sent Archangel Ratziel, (who reigns in the mysteries of the highest wisdom, Chokmah,) a book to give to Adam. This book was about the holy mysteries of the highest nature, the Holy wisdom of the 72 kinds of knowledge, virtue and power. In the Kabbalistic Tree of Life, these virtues were structured in nine groups of eight Angels, which are ruled over by its own Archangel. In the Aura-Soma Colour System we have our own interpretation of this. (PS-inconsistent with Bible)



## 2<sup>nd</sup> Parable- The House built on the Rock (Mt. 7:24-29)

24 "Therefore whoever hears this my WORD (Logos), and practices them, I will compare him to a wise man who laid the foundation of his house upon bedrock,

25 and the torrential rains poured down, the flood rose, and the winds blew and beat upon that house; but it did not collapse, for its foundation was secured upon bedrock.

26 "But all who hear My WORD, and do not practice them, will be compared to a moron; (stupid man) who constructed his house upon the sand:

27 and the torrential rains poured down, the floods rose, and the winds blew and beat on that house; and it collapsed, and great was its destruction."

28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had completed His WORD (Logos) that the crowds were astonished at His teachings,

29 because He taught them as an authoritative King, and not anything like the scribes words.






1. paid much in detail
