

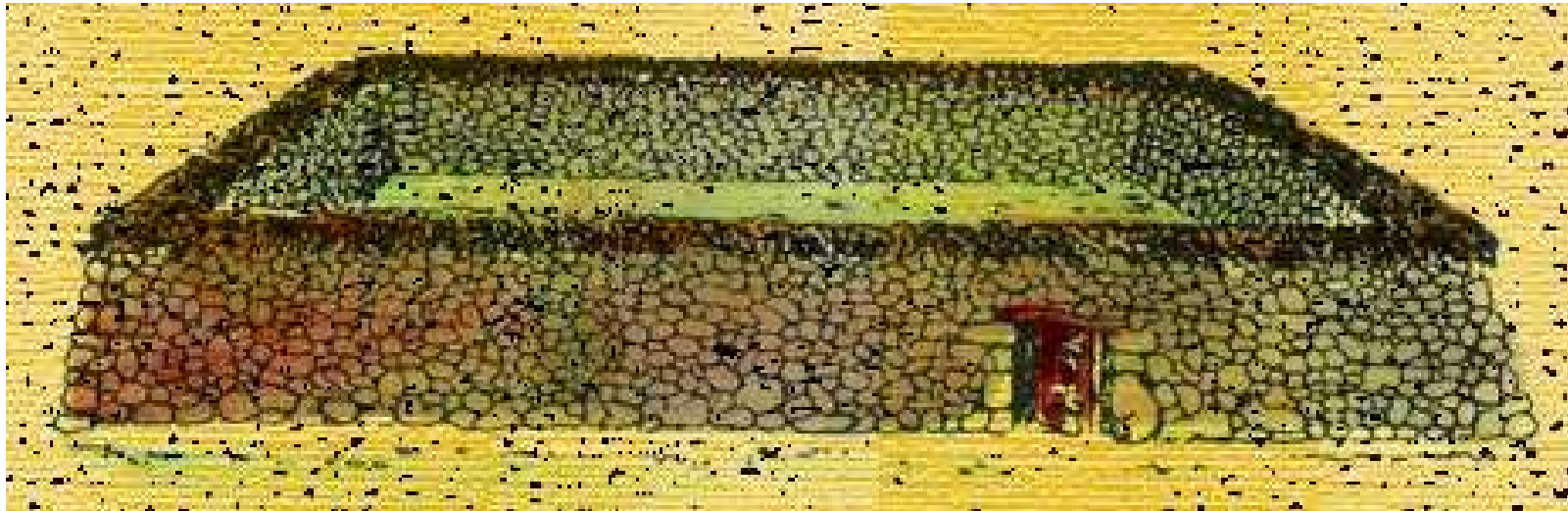

Backgrounder on Audience Familiarity

- Moses
 - You led Your people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron (Ps. 77:20)
- David
 - Psalm 23 The LORD is my shepherd..
- Prophets

• Prophet Ezekiel 34

- **1 ¶ The word of the LORD came to me:**
- **2 "Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel; prophesy and say to them: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: Woe to the shepherds of Israel who only take care of themselves! Should not shepherds take care of the flock?**
- **3 You eat the curds, clothe yourselves with the wool and slaughter the choice animals, but you do not take care of the flock.**
- **4 You have not strengthened the weak or healed the sick or bound up the injured. You have not brought back the strays or searched for the lost. You have ruled them harshly and brutally.**
- **5 So they were scattered because there was no shepherd, and when they were scattered they became food for all the wild animals.**
- **6 My sheep wandered over all the mountains and on every high hill. They were scattered over the whole earth, and no-one searched or looked for them.**
- **7 ¶ "Therefore, you shepherds, hear the word of the LORD:**
- **8 As surely as I live, declares the Sovereign LORD, because my flock lacks a shepherd and so has been plundered and has become food for all the wild animals, and because my shepherds did not search for my flock but cared for themselves rather than for my flock,**
- **9 therefore, O shepherds, hear the word of the LORD:**
- **10 This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I am against the shepherds and will hold them accountable for my flock.**

Backgrounder on Immediate Context



John 9:38 And (the seeing man) said, “Lord, I believe.” And he worshiped Him. And Jesus said, “For judgment I came into this world, so that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may become blind.” Those of the Pharisees who were with Him heard these things and said to Him, “We are not blind too, are we?”? Jesus said to them, “If you were blind, you would have no sin; but since you say, ‘We see,’ your sin₅ remains.



John 10:1 “Truly, truly, I say to you, **he who does not enter by the door into the **fold** of the **sheep**, but climbs up some other way, he is a thief and a robber. But he who enters by the door is a **shepherd** of the sheep. To him the **doorkeeper** opens, and the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out. When he puts forth all his own, he goes ahead of them, and the sheep follow him because they know his voice. A **stranger** they simply will not follow, but will flee from him, because they do not know the voice of strangers.” This **figure of speech** Jesus spoke to them, but they did not understand what those things were which He had been saying to them.**

2. *I AM The Door (v7-10)*

7 So Jesus said to them again, “Truly, truly, I say to you, I am **the door of the sheep. All who came before Me are **thieves and robbers**, but the sheep did not hear them. **I am the door**; **if anyone** enters through Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture. **The thief** comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I came that they may have life, and have it abundantly.**

- *I am the Door, the Saviour, with the salvation that is:*
 - *Unique*
 - *Exclusive*
 - *Free*
 - *Abundant*
 - *Living*
 - *Eternal*
 - *Secure*

3. I AM The Good Shepherd (v11 -18)

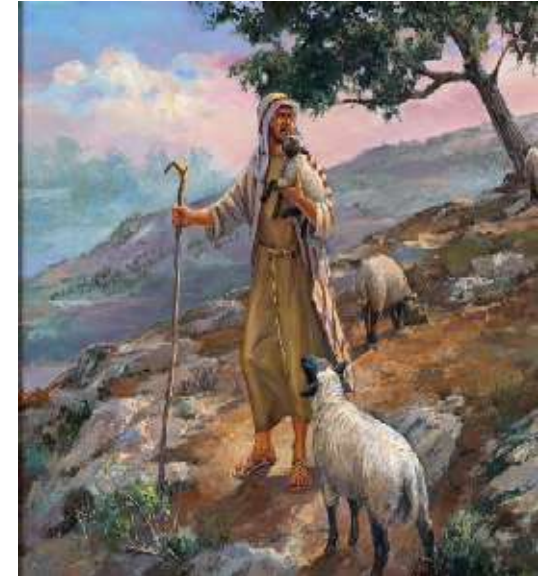
11 “I am the good shepherd; the good shepherd lays down His life for the sheep. 12 He who is a hired hand, and not a shepherd, who is not the owner of the sheep, sees the wolf coming, and leaves the sheep and flees, and the wolf snatches them and scatters them. 13 He flees because he is a hired hand and is not concerned about the sheep. 14 I am the good shepherd, and I know My own and My own know Me, 15 even as the Father knows Me and I know the Father; and I lay down My life for the sheep. 16 I have other sheep, which are not of this fold; I must bring them also, and they will hear My voice; and they will become one flock with one shepherd. 17 For this reason the Father loves Me, because I lay down My life so that I may take it again. 18 No one has taken it away from Me, but I lay it down on My own initiative. I have authority to lay it down, and I have authority to take it up again. This commandment I received from My Father.”

- **I AM the Good Shepherd**
 - **Intrinsically (I AM!)**
 - **Relationally (I know my sheep)**
 - **Protectively (I lay down my life)**
 - **Securely (I never abandon..)**
 - **Functionally (I lead them to..)**
 - **Universally (I must bring them..)**
 - **Sovereignly (can't be snatched..)**

- *Individually*

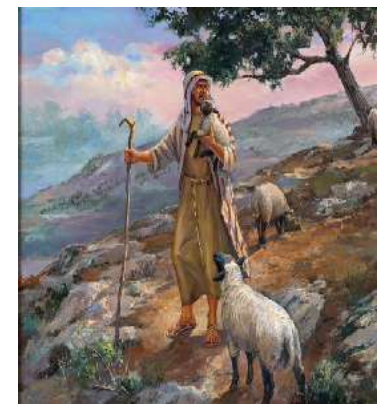
- *Heed His voice*
