- Strategic Location
  - Control of access between 2 seas
  - Romans destroyed city in 146 BC
  - Rebuilt by Julius Caesar in 46 BC
  - Populated with Roman war veterans, slaves, Greek, Jewish exiles from Rome
  - Trade, arts, Isthmian games
  - Temple of Poseidon
  - Culture of prostitutes









## The Church at Corinth Its Founding Acts 18:1-17

Then Paul left the synagogue and went next door to the house of Titius Justus, a worshipper of God. Crispus, the synagogue ruler, and his entire household believed in the Lord; and many of the Corinthians who heard him believed and were baptised.

One night the Lord spoke to Paul in a vision: "Do not be afraid; keep on speaking, do not be silent.

For I am with you, and no-one is going to attack and harm you, <u>because I have many</u> <u>people in this city.</u>"

"Then they all turned on Sosthenes the synagogue ruler and beat him in front of the court. But Gallio showed no concern whatever. Paul stayed on in Corinth for some time. 1 After this, Paul left Athens and went to Corinth.





## Where do we go when the going gets gruelling for us?


- When we don't know how to live in worlds of unbelief
