Through the authority given to Paul in Christ Jesus, he outlines the purpose of the Lord's Supper.

- The Lord, knowing what lay ahead of Him, (the betrayal, the sacrifice of His body and shedding of His blood) instructed that whenever partaking of the bread which represented His body that was broken for them; it was to be done in remembrance of He and He alone. 1Cor.11: 24
- And furthermore, when partaking of the cup, they were to remember Jesus Christ again for the new covenant that would always be found in His blood. 1Cor.11:25
- Quite simply, whenever the Lord's Supper was performed, it was solely for proclaiming the death of Jesus until He returns 1Cor11:26

Why is this so important to the members of the church at Corinth...to Paul?

- Their bodies are members of Christ and should reflect that difference to the world; they should not be desecrating the Body of Christ (which is the church) through the actions and activities they have been taking part in. 1Cor.6:15, 19, 20
- They are uniquely interwoven with God the Father and Christ Jesus; when they do not reflect this relationship, they sin against both their brothers and sisters as well as Christ. 1Cor8:6,12
- Are they better than their brothers and sisters in Christ?
 No, all have sinned and fallen short of God's glory; it is
 the exact reason they came to Christ, to be born again
 to a new body, redeemed in the eyes of God.

17 Regarding this next item, I'm not at all pleased. I am getting the picture that when you meet together it brings out your worst side instead of your best!

18 First, I get this report on your divisiveness, competing with and criticizing each other. I'm reluctant to believe it, but there it is.

19 The best that can be said for it is that the testing process will bring truth into the open and confirm it.

20 And then I find that you bring your divisions to worship - you come together, and instead of eating the Lord's Supper,

28 Examine your motives, test your heart, come to this meal in holy awe.

29 If you give no thought (or worse, don't care) about the broken body of the Master when you eat and drink, you're running the risk of serious consequences.

- 30 That's why so many of you even now are listless and sick, and others have gone to an early grave.
