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



Kathair from which we get the word catharsis referring to a cleansing process...it is the same word used when Jesus said of his disciples following the washing of their feet in John 13, when he said that they were "now clean or Kathairs through the word.


In vineyards, it is not uncommon for branches to become so heavy with fruit that they sad to the ground,

leaving stem vulnerable to the mud from the rainy season sure to follow. Consequently, the vine dresser, seeing a branch in the mud, lifts it up, braces it with string or cord or a pole, and washes the mud off the fruit..lovingly, tenderly, carefully





Shall I hide from Abraham what I am doing"? (Genesis 18:17)






