And he who receives a righteous man in the name of a righteous man shall receive a righteous man's reward. And whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold water in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall by no means lose his reward."

#### Matthew 10:40

#### Hebrews 2:10-12

Romans 2:7-10 - eternal life to those who by patient continuance in doing good seek for glory, honor, and immortality; ... 10 but **glory**, **honor**, **and peace** to everyone who works what is good

Romans 8:17 - and if children, then heirs-heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if indeed we suffer with Him, that we may also **be glorified** together.

Revelation 3:21 - To him who overcomes I will grant to <u>sit</u> with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne

## Matthew 10:42

And whoever gives one of these little ones only a cup of cold water in the name of a disciple, assuredly, I say to you, he shall by no means lose his reward.

Matthew 18:2-6 - Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them, and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as <u>little children</u>, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven. Therefore whoever humbles himself as this <u>little child</u> is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Whoever receives one <u>little child</u> like this in My name receives Me.

"Whoever causes one of <u>these little ones</u> who believe in Me to sin, it would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were drowned in the depth of the sea.

Matthew 25:40 - And the King will answer and say to them, 'Assuredly, I say to you, inasmuch as you did it to one of the <u>least</u> <u>of these</u> My brethren, you did it to Me.'

Mark 9:41 - For whoever gives you a cup of water to drink in My name, because you belong to Christ, assuredly, I say to you, he will by no means lose his reward.

Luke 17:1-2 - It is impossible that no offences should come, but woe to him through whom they do come! It would be better for him if a millstone were hung around his neck, and he were thrown into the sea, than that he should offend one of these <u>little ones</u>.
