Ephesians 4:1-16









Ephesians 4:7-13 NIV But to each one of us grace has been given as Christ apportioned it. This is why it says:



to equip his people for works of service, so that the body of Christ may be built up


until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ.



Psalm 68:18 NIV When you ascended on high, you took many captives;






- When you ascended on high, you took many captives; you received gifts from people, even from the rebellious -

- Because of your temple at Jerusalem kings will bring you gifts.




