Step of Obedience

- obey your parents in the Lord
 - "Honour your father and mother" (this is the first commandment with a promise), ³ "that it may go well with you and that you may live long in the land."
- Outward action flows from an inward attitude
 - fuelled by a devotion to God in Christ Jesus
 - honour, that is, out of respect or reverence

Instructions for Fathers

Instructions for Fathers The Negative

There must always be room for repentance (for both parties)

Instructions for Fathers The Positive

bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord

- present the Lord Jesus to our children in such a way that they will learn to love Him with their whole being
- point them beyond our parental authority to the authority of the God of the universe

Slaves and Masters

Slaves, obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ, not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart, rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man, knowing that whatever good anyone does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether he is a slave or free. Employees


Obedience from the heart

- ...obey your earthly masters with fear and trembling, with a sincere heart, as you would Christ,
- not by the way of eye-service, as people-pleasers, but as servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart,
- rendering service with a good will as to the Lord and not to man,

Recognize and Remember

- 1. our *earthly masters* have no authority over our relationship to the living God
 - the Lord God has done everything we need for redemption (we owe Him our lives)
- 2. our role is more than that of an employee
 - ambassadors for the Kingdom of our Lord and Saviour
- 3. serving our Lord more than human management
 - for the Lord Jesus and not merely for the approval of the boss
 - desire the best for those over us

Recognize and Remember



Employers

Masters, do the same to them, and stop your threatening, knowing that he who is both their Master and yours is in heaven, and that there is no partiality with him.

Employers (Masters)

- answerable to Jesus Christ for his actions
- act towards their slaves with the:
 - same regard for God's will,
 - same recognition of Christ's authority,
 - same sincerity and good will which had been enjoined on the slaves
- treat the slaves with concern for their well-being, as brothers and sisters in Christ and not as property

Employers - Remember

- the God of heaven is the slave's God also
- before God there is no slave or master
- all of us are sinners in need of God's redemption.
- God will judge each according to his works
 - not according to his status
